IR(R)

With autumn now upon us the risk of inclement weather has the potential to impact on the safety of a flight. Whilst it is never to be considered a replacement for a full instrument rating having your IR(R), formerly the IMC rating is an essential addition to your PPL. The ability to legally and confidently continue a flight into cloud and make an ILS approach is a satisfying experience and in addition, these new skills will also hone your overall airmanship and handling.

To obtain your IR(R) you will need:

- At least 10 hours of flying post obtaining your PPL
- 15 hours of IR(R) instruction
- Pass one multiple choice exam
- Pass the IR(R) Skills Test - typically 1 - 1.5 hours in duration
- To pay the £160 test fee



Once completed you will have the following privileges added to your licence (in respect of UK registered AC whilst in UK airspace):

- Undertake flight in IMC outside controlled airspace, (in Class G) and IFR flight in Class D or E controlled airspace with appropriate permission
- Undertake flight out of sight of surface with a minimum take off and landing in 1800m visibility
- Undertake let-down and Approach Procedures to published Decision Height or Minimum Descent Height and to undertake missed approach procedures.
